2. Points obtained for subjects listed in the high school transcript issued in Canada will be directly transferred for the recruitment procedures. A subject must be passed in order to be considered.
3. Candidates obligated to submit a current MCAT exam results who present a certificate with a score not lower than 492 points, passed not earlier than in 2022, will be qualified based on this result converted to qualification points.
4. Candidates who took NEET exam and present a certificate of a current score falling within at least 60th centile, passed not earlier than in 2022, will be qualified based on this result converted to qualification points.
5. In case the tables above do not include a country from which a candidate obtained high school diploma or if the applied scale of grades is different, the entity conducting the recruitment procedure will calculate foreign high school diploma results individually using a method corresponding to the ones applied in the tables. The candidate is required to provide a scale of assessments from the country where the certificate was issued.
