The result of the entrance exam expressed as a percentage will be converted to points as per the following rule: 1% = 1 point

2. Points obtained for subjects listed in the high school transcript issued in Canada will be directly transferred for the recruitment procedures. A subject must be passed in order to be considered.
3. Candidates obligated to submit a current MCAT exam results who present a certificate with a score not lower than 492 points, passed not earlier than in 2023, will be qualified based on this result converted to qualification points.
4. In the case of having other certificates/documents with results obtained from other exams, the candidate should send scanned copies of them to the Recruitment Section for verification along with the other required documents.
5. In case the tables above do not include a country from which a candidate obtained high school diploma or if the applied scale of grades is different, the entity conducting the recruitment procedure will calculate foreign high school diploma results individually using a method corresponding to the ones applied in the tables. The candidate is obligated

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to provide a scale of assessments from the country where the certificate was issued.

6. The above tables are the initial general information for candidates and the final result is calculated and uploaded to the system by the Recruitment Commissions after the scanned documents sent by the candidates within the due date indicated by the University have been analysed.
